APPLICATION PROCEDURE The following materials are required to be considered for acceptance to Graceland:

High School, Homeschool and Transfer Students

- A completed application and **\$50 application fee**. You may mail this form or submit our online application. (Fee is waived if application is submitted online: www.graceland.edu/apply.)
- Upon acceptance a \$200 institutional deposit is required to reserve your place in the class, to preregister for classes, to reserve your financial aid package, and to receive your room assignment.

High School Students

- An OFFICIAL high school transcript, including at least six semesters of credits. Send a final (official) transcript after your high school graduation.
- Your class rank.
- OFFICIAL transcripts of any college courses taken. These must be sent from the college directly to Graceland.
- Submit ACT and/or SAT test results, Graceland's ACT code number is 1314; the SAT code is 6249.
- **Canadian Citizens:** Submit ACT and/or SAT test results to be considered for an academic scholarship or varsity athletic eligibility.

International Students: Submit a TOEFL score if English is not your first language. Graceland's TOEFL code is 6249.

Resident Aliens: Include a photocopy of your resident alien card.

General Equivalency Diploma (GED): OFFICIAL test scores, if applicable.

Homeschool Students

- A portfolio demonstrating the breadth and depth of learning by the applicant.*
OR
- A homeschool transcript prepared by the teachers/parents, an independent or supervising teacher or an organization with which the homeschooler is registered or affiliated.*
- OFFICIAL transcripts of any college courses taken. These must be sent from the college directly to Graceland.
- Submit ACT and/or SAT test results, Graceland's ACT code number is 1314; the SAT code is 6249.

*Further descriptions of the portfolio and transcript are available from the Admissions Office and on our Web site.

Transfer Students

- An OFFICIAL high school transcript showing your graduation date. (If you have a college degree, neither high school transcripts nor GED scores are required.)
- OFFICIAL transcripts of any college courses taken. These must be sent from the college directly to Graceland. (You must be accepted before an official transcript evaluation can be made.)

From Kansas City, Missouri (approximately 120 miles): Travel Interstate 35 North to Exit 4. Turn left off of the exit onto US 69. Turn left onto Linden Street. Turn left onto College Avenue and follow it to the campus.
