THE VISION SCHOLARSHIP

The Vision Scholarship is designed to recognize Community of Christ youth and youth who are church friends who have a vision for the future direction of the Community of Christ. Graceland will present three scholarships which are renewable for up to four years. These scholarships are: first place - \$2,500; second place - \$2,000; and third place - \$1,500.

GRANT ELIGIBILITY

- Must be entering senior year in high school.
- Must be a Spectacular Participant.
- Must apply for admission to Graceland University.

Students eligible for tuition benefit may apply. Awards may be subject to certain restrictions.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

In addition to an Application for Admission to Graceland University, submit a typed essay and cover sheet to the Admissions Office by noon on the Tuesday of Spectacular. You may mail or fax your essay and application materials, but you must also submit the original signed copy of your Graceland application to the Admissions Office.

Cover Sheet: Include the following information: date, name, phone number, e-mail, male/female, parent's name, high school, and graduation date.

Essay and Commitment Statement: Must be double spaced — 1,000 words or less. This is your opportunity to share your vision of the future of the Community of Christ and the direction it should take as it deals with the issues of today and those on the horizon.

Include a brief commitment statement explaining what you plan to do to make that vision a reality.
