

Bachelor of Arts Degree – Accounting Major

In addition to the general education requirements, majors in Accounting must complete a concentration of 40 semester hours in Accounting, Business, Economics, and Computer Science/Information Technology including the courses listed in the major requirements.

Total Credits Required for Degree: 124 semester hours to include a minimum of 32 semester hours with Graceland, and 39 semester hours upper division credit. A maximum of 75 semester hours of transfer credit is accepted from community colleges.

[Students who have earned an associate degree with at least 60 semester hours applicable for transfer, and a minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA, or at least 48 semester hours applicable for transfer and a minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA will follow these Alternative General Education requirements. The Associate of Arts degree will satisfy more of these general education requirements than other associate degrees. SWCC course prerequisites must also be completed.]
