PERFORMANCE GRANT IN ART

SCHOLARSHIPS

Graceland offers grants in art to those students committed to majoring in the art curriculum. Awards are available for students in the areas of painting, drawing, sculpture, ceramics, photography and commercial design. Requirements are as follows:

Portfolio review

Eight to ten pieces of your best work are required. Actual artwork must be professionally presented: matted, mounted and contained in a portfolio. A personal visit is always preferred, but if you live too far away from campus to make this practical, 8–10 color slides of your best works or a CD of digital jpeg images are acceptable. Best results are obtained when art is photographed against neutral (gray) backgrounds. While digital images or slides are preferred, 2D portfolios may be hand delivered for review (do not mail 3D work or glass).

Letter of recommendation

A letter of recommendation from your art instructor must be received by the Graceland Admissions Office before a grant recommendation can be made.

Portfolio Review Arrangements

To schedule a portfolio review, contact the Graceland Admissions Office. If you do an on-campus review, remember to have this application completed and your letter of recommendation ready no later than the time of your review. We would prefer to receive these at least one week prior to your review. If you send slides or a CD of your portfolio, you may send these documents with your images. **They should be received by the Graceland Admissions Office by May 1, prior to the academic year you wish to attend.**

STUDENT EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Student work assignments may be available in the art department as faculty assistants and production assistants. Complete the Graceland Student Work Application and notify the Chairperson of the Division of Fine Arts of your interest.
