THEATRE PRODUCTION GRANT

Graceland University offers Theatre Production Grants to talented and promising young performers, designers, and technicians whose academic qualifications and demonstrated theatrical abilities indicate that they could make a significant contribution to the theatre program of the university. The amount of these awards is determined by several factors including student ability, financial need, and specific needs within the theatre department.

Recipients of a Theatre Production Grant must do the following:

- Enroll in THTR2350 Theatre Production Studies.
- Attend a Theatre Orientation Meeting at the beginning of the semester.
- Participate in at least one theatre production per semester.
- Maintain a 2.8 GPA.

More specific information will be provided in a Grant Confirmation Letter from Financial Aid Services.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. An **audition** or **interview** is required.

Auditions are generally offered to students who have experience in performance. On-campus auditions are preferable, but a high-quality videotape is acceptable. Please bring (or send) a résumé of your theatrical experience, and a headshot if you have one. Your audition will be a memorized monologue, two–three minutes in length, from a play or musical. At the beginning of your audition, state your name, the name of the character you are portraying, the name of the play, and the playwright's name. Choose material that will showcase your abilities.

Interviews are generally offered to students who have experience in design and/or technical areas. On-campus interviews are preferable, but phone interviews are acceptable. Please bring (or send) a résumé of your theatrical experience. If possible, you should also submit a portfolio of your work. The portfolio may include prompt book materials, drawings, renderings, light/sound/props plots, photographs of your work, and any other appropriate materials. Portfolios may also be presented online or on CD.
