Day 1 - Tu May 5, 2020 -- LOS ANGELES - SOUTH PACIFIC



Depart USA.

Your fascinating "Down Under" discovery begins today as you board your award-winning Qantas Airways flight. you will depart on flight QF0016 departing at 11.20pm. Flight will make a connection to Brisbanne to reach Auckland (NZ)

Day 2 - We May 6, 2020 - EN ROUTE TO THE SOUTH PACIFIC



Enroute. Cross the International Dateline and "lose" one day en route. You'll "regain" this day when flying from Australia back to the USA at the conclusion of your journey!

Day 3 - Th May 7, 2020 - AUCKLAND, NZ



Afternoon arrival in the lively harbor city of Auckland on New Zealand's North Island with flight QF0119 arriving at 2pm. You'll be greeted at the airport and escorted to your upscale city-center hotel. Join your tour director for a **welcome drink and a brief orientation walk**. Accommodation at hotel

Day 4 - Fr May 8, 2020 - AUCKLAND, NZ

Day 09 - We May 13, 2020 - DUNEDIN



This morning embark on an orientation tour of Dunedin. Day 11 - Fr May 15, 2020 - NEW ZEALAND - MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA

Arrive in Melbourne, the stately capital of the State of Victoria noted for its vibrant culture, spacious parks and beautiful gardens. It is a nightly ritual that will enthrall you as you observe the "parade" from the elevated boardwalk. Accommodation at the hotel **(B)**

Day 13 - Sn May 17, 2020 - MELBOURNE/CAIRNS, AU



Today fly northward to tropical Cairns, gateway to the Great Barrier Reef. Your centrally located hotel is close to the Esplanade and the ocean. Relax and enjoy your hotel's swimming pool! Accommodation at the hotel **(B)**

Day 14 - Mn May 18, 2020 - CAIRNS, AU - GREEN ISLAND EXCURSION

Day 17 - Th May 21, 2020 - SYDNEY

QUEENSTOWN - SKYLINE WITH DINNER TOUR

Around \$70 PER PERSON



You'll travel by gondola (cable car) to the top of Bob's Peak, overlooking Queenstown. Here, you'll indulge in a lavish buffet dinner at the Skyline Restaurant while savoring the wonderful views of the town, the lake and the surrounding mountains. Meeting point at

QUEENSTOWN - WALTER PEAK FARM AND CRUISE

Around \$64 PER PERSON



Board the vintage steamship TSS Enslow for an afternoon cruise across Lake Wakatipu to Walter Peak Farm, where you'll enjoy afternoon tea, stroll around the beautiful lakeside gardens, and see farm animals and work demonstrations before steaming back to Queenstown later in the afternoon. Meeting point at the harbor in the city.

DUNEDIN - OTAGO PENINSULA/LARNACH CASTLE/WILDLIFE CRUISE Around \$95 PER PERSON



Embark on a guided afternoon excursion to the scenic Otago Peninsula. From Dunedin, you'll take the spectacular "High Road," offering amazing views of both the Pacific Ocean and Otago Harbor. When you arrive at Larnach Castle, you'll travel back in time on a guided tour of New Zealand's only castle, built in 1871. Learn the scandalous and tragic history of the Castle and why William Larnach took his own life. See the magnificent carved ceilings, antigues and craftsmanship. You'll have an opportunity to

take photos of the Castle and gardens before continuing to Wellers Rock, where you'll embark on a one-hour wildlife cruise. Witness the diversity and abundance of wildlife on spectacular Taiaroa Head, the world's only mainland nesting place for the Northern Royal Albatross. The region is also home to fur seals, dolphins, sea lions, an array of rarely seen ocean birds and marine mammals in their natural environment. Following the cruise, you'll return to your Dunedin hotel late in the afternoon.



MELBOURNE - EXCURSION TO PHILLIP ISLAND

Depart your hotel this afternoon and travel to Phillip Island, which boasts the world's largest reserve of fairy penguins. Every evening at sunset, these fairy penguins come home from a long day of fishing at sea to their burrows in the sand dunes. It is a nightly ritual that will enthrall you as you observe this waddling "parade" of 13-inch-tall flightless birds from an elevated boardwalk. After this adorable penguin procession, you'll return to the hotel in the late evening.
