Theatre Production Addresses Global Issue

"LIGHTING THE WAY" presented Graceland's theatre audience with different perspectives on climate change through 12 short vignettes — some silly and some intense, but all thought-provoking. The Graceland performance was part of a global network of public forums on the subject of climate change under the umbrella of The Arctic Cycle consortium. The Climate Change Theatre Action, a participating group, offers a menu of 50 short scenes for stage performance. Of those, Graceland chose 12 for the local production. This scene, "Canary," was selected to be performed at the annual Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival Region 5, held in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, Jan. 19-25, 2020.

ABOVE Jessie Fuller '20 enacted the scene from "Canary" by Hanna Cormick, a poetic piece dedicated to those who put their life/body on the line, voluntarily and involuntarily, to bring about awareness of climate change, like canaries in the coal mine. Assistant Professor of Theatre Tracy Salter dedicated this scene to her friend and former professor who suffers from multiple chemical sensitivity (MCS). Susceptible to environmental toxins, individuals with MCS are characterized as canaries because their bodies can no longer process certain poisons in the air, water or food sources, and are early indicators of a danger.



Fly Like a Bird

In November, **JANA ZINSER '80** **SHARED A LIVE READING OF HER LATEST NOVEL**, inspired by her experiences growing up in Lamoni. *Fly Like A Bird*, Zinser's second novel, tells the coming-of-age story of Ivy, a young girl growing up in a small southern Iowa town during the 1970s, where everyone knows everything about their quirky neighbors. After discovering that her family and neighbors are keeping secrets from her about the night a tragic car crash killed her parents, Ivy attempts to untangle the truth about what really happened and escape the town that lied to her about the true fate of her mother. The reading, followed by a question-and-answer session, took place in the Frederick Madison Smith Library on the Lamoni campus.



Nine Students Inducted Into Sigma Tau Delta Honor Society

The **GRACELAND CHAPTER OF THE INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH HONOR SOCIETY** **INDUCTED NINE NEW MEMBERS** in October.

Graceland's chapter, Alpha Phi Upsilon, was founded in 2017, and these new members are part of the third class of inductees. Sigma Tau Delta was founded in 1924 to confer distinction for high achievement in English language, literature and writing, and to foster literacy and all aspects of the discipline of English. With over 850 chapters across the U.S. and abroad, Sigma Tau Delta is the most active honors organization in the field and one of the largest members of the Association of College Honor Societies.

Giving BACK

Just before Christmas, a group of about 40 Graceland staff members, faculty, administrators and athletic coaches gathered together for an **ADMISSIONS SUMMIT** aimed at addressing several enrollment challenges the university is facing.

Helming the sessions were two Graceland alumni — **IVAN JOSEPH, PhD, '96** and **MIKE SEAGRAVES, PhD, '94** — who have been partnering together on workshops like this for 10 years. Both of these men have served Graceland in different capacities over the past several years.

Seagraves came to Graceland in 1990, but its influence on him began much earlier. He remembers when he was about 10 years old, a large group of Graceland alumni moved into the area and started attending his church in Silicon Valley.

"There was something about them — folks like Scott '84 and Laurie Parker '84 White, Randy Arms '84 and Brian Vreeland '84 — that I just wanted to be a part of," he recalls.

At Graceland, Seagraves never met an activity he didn't love. He played football and soccer, served as Closson's chaplain, then as their house president. He was homecoming king alongside his future sister-in-law, Deb Knotts '93 Skinner (Seagraves is married to Deb's twin, Ruth '93) and was the president of the Council of House Presidents. In his spare time, he participated in theatre and choir.

But Seagraves almost didn't make it to Graceland. As a talented football prospect, he actually was committed to another university, having only visited Graceland for "maybe half a day when I was about 15," he recounts. Then, as a senior, he attended Spectacular, Community of Christ's annual high school camp on Graceland's Lamoni campus, and he just didn't leave. "I remember sitting in the Gunsolley parking lot, watching the Calizonia (a Spectacular delegation) bus drive away. I stayed in Lamoni by myself until football started two weeks later," he remembers.

Joseph admits his own path to Graceland wasn't exactly straight. He had been exposed to Graceland thanks to Brian Shantz '69,

whose Canadian delegation at Spectacular has always been impressive. However, Joseph started his college career at Laurentian in Sudbury, Ontario, but found the large school and class sizes difficult.

After taking a year off, he joined a group of Canadian students for a Graceland visit and thought he might have found home. After an interview with then Vice President for Enrollment Management Bonita Booth, Joseph joined Graceland in 1993 to play soccer. He went on to serve as the Orion house president and the Graceland Student Government (GSG) president in the 1995-96 school year. Joseph also met his wife, Polly Tripp '95 Joseph, while a student at Graceland.

After graduation, Joseph joined the residence life team as the Gunsolley hall director and was a volunteer assistant coach for the men's soccer team.

"I was in the right place at the right time," said Joseph when asked how he came to be the head coach. "I was actually about to move on from Graceland and join an NCAA Division I school as an assistant, and Jerry Hampton '52 told me that I would be better to learn by fire as the head coach at Graceland than to be an assistant at a larger school. And he was so right. There are

Joseph stayed at Graceland a few more years, leading the men's and women's soccer teams to unprecedented success, including #1 national rankings and a national championship in 2006 for the men's team — Graceland's first national men's soccer title in history. He was named national coach of the year by the NAIA in 2006 as well.

Beginning in 2008, Joseph spent a decade as director of athletics at Ryerson University in Toronto, leading the transformation that saw the program rise to national prominence. He created a culture of belonging and pride across Ryerson's diverse urban campus and helped student-athletes break records with their athletic, academic and outreach activities. His efforts also helped the university win the first-ever provincial and national championships in the institution's history.

Joseph earned his PhD in sports psychology and is regularly called upon to support national team programs. Two recent examples include his 2018 selection as head coach of the women's national soccer team in his native Guyana and his role as

several coaches like Jerry who have seen immense success during their time at Graceland — from Stew McDole '65 to Rod Schall '50. These were coaches who received national acclaim."

It was during Joseph's time as a coach at Graceland that he invited Seagraves to return to Lamoni as a residence hall director. "I was just out of occupational therapy school and in a really difficult internship, but Graceland called to me, despite having a job lined up for myself in Bend, Oregon," Seagraves said. "I had to put the personal ahead of the professional, and it was the best decision of my life." But with the best of both worlds, Seagraves was still able to work as a part-time occupational therapist (OT) at the Lamoni nursing home.

Both men eventually left Graceland for new opportunities. Seagraves returned to California in 2001 to pursue his career in health care in earnest. Beginning as an OT, he soon made his way into progressive and transformational leadership roles — first clinically, then in health care information technology and, ultimately, into corporate executive leadership.

Currently, Seagraves is a national vice president for Kaiser Permanente, an \$80 billion national integrated health care system with over 200,000 employees, where he leads the teams responsible for Kaiser's \$600 million consumer digital transformation. Along the way, he earned a PhD in global leadership and organizational change from Pepperdine University.

high-performance coach for the Canadian men's basketball team that won the country's first-ever FIBA Under-19 Basketball World Cup in 2017.

Along with being an in-demand consultant and speaker, Joseph maintains an influential presence in the public realm. He contributes regularly to publications like *The Huffington Post* and *Globe and Mail*. He also wrote the 2017 book "You Got This: Mastering the Skill of Self-Confidence" and delivered a TEDx talk called "The Skill of Self-Confidence," which has been viewed, at last count, over 18 million times. Joseph is now the vice-provost at Dalhousie University in Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada.

Seagraves and Joseph have stayed in touch since leaving Graceland. In 2009, when Joseph was the athletic director at Ryerson, he asked Seagraves to be a part of an all-day session to help the university reach its peak performance. A decade later, they've done over a dozen workshops together in businesses and institutions across North America, helping to create high-performance culture.

"We have complementary skillsets, and because we are so different, we play off of each other in that space really well," Joseph said.

For both of them, their time as part of the residence life program at Graceland was formative. The influence of legends like former dean of students Tom Powell '73 and former director of residence life Marian Garrett '70 Killpack looms largely in their language and in their conversation.

Both talked at length about Powell's message of the ministry of presence and its importance to their lives. Joseph shared a particular story about Killpack's impact: "Marian wrote my parents a letter. I'm not sure if she did that for all the students in the residence life program, but her letter to my parents helped mend a rocky relationship because she described the positive impact I was having on others at Graceland."

In returning to Graceland this winter to offer the complimentary two-day admissions workshop, they both felt it was so important for them to give back.

"We saw this as an opportunity to reflect back to the Graceland community how unique and special it truly is," said Seagraves. "Through the lens of our leadership experience, we recognized that what Graceland needs most right now are the very things it is uniquely gifted at — all the things it taught us about the value of relationships, the strength of community, and how to live and lead with purpose."

Joseph shared his own deep sense of gratitude. "This place changed my life and set me on a trajectory that put me in a different place than I was headed. As a board of trustees member, I understand the urgency in ensuring Graceland's admissions challenges are addressed."

It's clear that Joseph and Seagraves have an immense amount of respect for each other. When asked to describe Seagraves, Joseph said, "He's the smartest guy I know. He's analytical and

impeccable in his conscientiousness. He is a strong man of faith and principle, and his family is the most important thing to him."

Seagraves said about Joseph, "He is brilliant in his way of understanding what really matters in both people and organizations. His ability to focus on the nonintuitive thing that makes people and teams better is a gift. And the way in which he is able to build a community, a movement, a culture around those things is really intentional and yet authentic and organic. Beneath the surface, there is a passion for people and unleashing their potential."

Seagraves and Joseph are two shining examples of the types of people Graceland has the potential to develop. Their willingness to give back to the university that gave them so much is evident in their passion and persistence in helping ensure that Graceland reaches its potential. ■

During the admissions summit, those in attendance engaged in a variety of team-building exercises — some fast-paced and some more intensive — all designed to draw out creative thinking and get people to identify challenges and possible solutions. It was a true meeting of the minds, a time for new perspectives. Attendees watched two powerful videos that encouraged this thought.

Seagraves set the stage for renowned *National Geographic* photographer Dewitt Jones' short film, "More Than One Right Answer." It offered the message that creativity is a matter of perspective, there is more than one right answer to a problem, and embracing change allows us to break the pattern(s) and look for the next right answer.

Joseph described the framework behind Apple's 1997 advertising campaign, "Think Different," showing the iconic commercial of visionaries throughout history who made significant impacts *because they thought differently*. The unique thinking that drove this pivotal campaign and celebrated unique thinkers was exactly what Joseph and Seagraves wanted to impress upon the summit group. Alumni & Friends Making a Difference

Each year at homecoming, Graceland's president presents the following awards of recognition in honor of impactful service to Graceland and the world.

The **Distinguished Service Award** recognizes achievement in a chosen field, service to community, state and nation, good citizenship, humanitarian service and contribution to society. The recipient must be a living alumni of Graceland, and it must be 10 years since they were enrolled at Graceland.

The **Graceland Award of Recognition** honors those who have demonstrated special contributions of time, talents, resources and personal sacrifices to benefit Graceland. The recipients must be living but need not be Graceland alumni. The Board of Trustees asked the Alumni Association to establish this award as an additional way to honor the people who support Graceland and university programs in an exceptional way.

The **Honorary Alumni Award** recognizes, includes and honors individuals — living or deceased — who have not been enrolled as students at Graceland but whose affiliation would be beneficial to Graceland. These individuals have related to the goals and purposes of the university and to other alumni as though they had been a member of the student body.

This year's honorees were recognized at the 20th annual Alumni Awards Banquet held on Friday evening of homecoming weekend in Shaw Center.

Distinguished Service Award



David Vaughan '75, a renowned aquaculture researcher, has made a name for himself worldwide with numerous published papers and notoriety on his coral growth research. Vaughan, of Summerland Keys, Florida, earned a Bachelor of Arts in biology and chemistry from Graceland. He went on to earn a Master of Science in biology and microbiology from Fairleigh Dickinson University, and a PhD in botany and plant physiology from Rutgers University.

Through his work as a senior scientist at the Mote's Elizabeth Moore International Center for Coral Reef Research & Restoration Center in the Florida Keys, Vaughan discovered a process called micro fragmentation, a way to speed up the growth rate of coral. He postponed his retirement to work on restoring corals at Florida's Reef Tract, the third-largest coral reef in the world. Vaughan is now the president and founder of Plant A Million Corals LLC, which was created for the purpose of training marine biologists all over the world in coral restoration and replenishment. He credits his time at Graceland for giving him the drive and passion for this lifelong love and mission.

Graceland Award of Recognition



Bob Bell '86 was a high school senior in Port Huron, Michigan, when Graceland football coach Dan Hanton '65 urged him to visit the campus with six friends. Bell fell in love with Graceland and enrolled in the fall of 1977. He earned a Bachelor of Arts in physical education and health with an elementary education endorsement.

Bell has devoted his life to public service — as an educator for 17 years, in the Army Reserves serving several tours of duty and training soldiers, and as a law enforcement officer. In his role as Lamoni police chief from 2015-19, Bell worked side by side with Dean of Students Dave Schaal '80, turning college students in the right direction through personal mentoring and counseling.



Steve '77 and Jeanie Upson thrive on getting the most out of Mother Earth, and Graceland has reaped the fruits of their labor. Steve came to Graceland in the fall of 1973 from Tulsa, Oklahoma. He transferred to Oklahoma State University, where he earned his Bachelor of Science in horticulture in 1978 and went on to earn his Master of Science in horticulture from Kansas State University in 1980. Over the years, he has served

as a technical advisor and educator in the areas of raised-bed and container gardening, commercial market gardening, and high tunnel (hoop house) construction and management. Jeanie is from Skiatook, Oklahoma, and received her Bachelor of Arts in elementary education from Cameron University. She has been a Title I elementary reading specialist for Ardmore City Schools for the past 32 years.



Endowment Growth

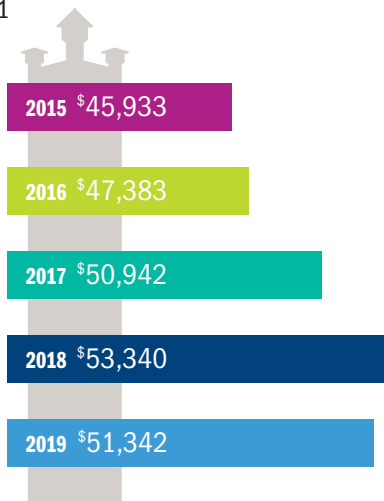

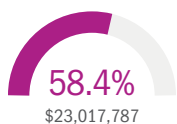

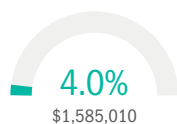

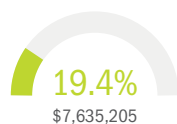

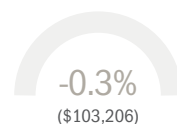
Net Tuition & Fees



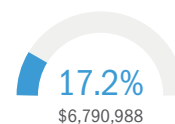
Government Grants & Contracts



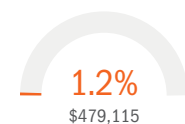
Private Gifts, Grants & Contracts

AUSTRALIA

Australia was first represented by John Blackmore and William Patterson, who enrolled as religious education students from Sydney in 1921-22. Patterson became Australia's first collegiate student at Graceland in 1922-23.

GERMANY

Germany was first represented by Freda Haas, a 1908-09 preparatory student enrolled from Brockenheim, also the first Graceland student from Europe. Germany's first male student was Karl Green, who enrolled in the preparatory department in 1914-15.

GENERAL COLLEGE

The general college curriculum, as referenced in the 1959 Graceland College catalog, required work in five academic divisions and was designed for students who wished to achieve a broadly based general education.

SECRETARIAL STUDIES

A business major toward a bachelor's degree in executive secretarial was offered from 1961-62 through 1966-67. One- and two-year certificate programs in secretarial science were introduced in the fall of 1979 and were last offered in the 1985-87 catalog.

EDUCATION

The normal department, later referred to as the education department, was organized in 1903. Ruth L. Smith was the first instructor. Professor Charles B. Woodstock was in charge of the department. In the spring of 1912, the normal program was an arrangement for student teachers to teach the children from the Children's Home in Lamoni.

Graceland's elementary education major was introduced as a bachelor's degree program in 1960. In addition to grades K-6, three concentration programs were added in 1988-89: secondary education (grades 7-12), and elementary (K-6 endorsement) and combination (K-6 and 7-12 modified teacher education program) for students majoring in art, music or physical education.

Today, the Gleazer School of Education is noted for excellence in providing a technology emphasis, psychological and sociological foundations, and learning theory. Coursework is balanced by extensive field experiences in school settings.

Updating the Fitz Equipment

The Fitzgerald Fitness Center opened in 2012 and was an effort to improve the health and well-being of students. Over the past seven years, “The Fitz,” as it’s known, has been a space of constant use for our students. Originally funded by a generous gift from **Bob and Jan Braun '61 Fitzgerald**, the facility has three areas: a group exercise area for classes like yoga and Zumba, an aerobic area with elliptical machines and treadmills, and an anaerobic area that holds some small dumbbells, kettle bells and other free weights.

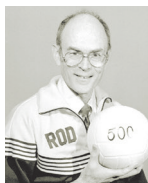

VARSITY STATUS

Toward the end of the 1969 spring season, the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) introduced a national volleyball tournament for men. Only varsity squads could compete in the event, so Graceland's administration granted varsity status to its club team.

COACH HIGHLIGHT

Rod Schall '50 was head coach from 1967-1993. He amassed approximately 900 wins during his career, including three of the national championships listed below. He became a pioneer in the development of computerized volleyball statistics, acquiring the nickname "Statman." Schall served with the volleyball statistics team for the 1984 and 1996 Olympics. He was named to the Yellowjackets Hall of Fame (1992) and NAIA Athletics Hall of Fame (1995).

CHAMPIONSHIP TITLES

The men's volleyball program won the NAIA National Volleyball Championship title in 1973, 1976 and 1979.

The program won the NIRSA (National Intramural-Recreational Sports Association) National Championship in 1998, during a period of time in which men's volleyball was not a championship sport in the NAIA.

NCAA PLAY

The Graceland team became part of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Volleyball Association with the season that began in January 1987, putting the Yellowjackets in NCAA Division I play.

“I believe we are navigating the journey between the continuity of our values and mission with an everchanging and ever more complex world.”

Over and over, we hear that higher education is changing, and it is — rapidly. The days when a student applied to one or two schools, attended one of them on campus for four years and graduated with a bachelor's degree are disappearing rapidly. Students now compare financial aid packages from multiple schools before choosing based on cost, degree programs are earned online, and the public is even growing skeptical about the essential value of higher education. To survive, universities must prove that what they offer is worth the investment and better than the competition. Those that do not, disappear.

For Graceland, however, the challenge is not just delivering well-designed courses. Of course, we need to do that, but we must also be true to our core identity: a genuine community of integrity and authenticity that focuses on developing citizens empowered to make a better, more sustainable world community. While that goal remains constant, the way to achieve that in 2020 cannot just be what worked in the past. Graceland Forever

DEB KNOTTS '93 SKINNER *has been a member of the Graceland community for as long as she can remember, and now, she is bringing her lifelong passion for the university and what it has to offer to Graceland's admissions office as dean of undergraduate admissions.*

She recalls her first memories of Graceland: "I was in Kelly Hall, the old art building, and my oldest brother, Dan Knotts, was attending as an art major. I think I was about five years old; he sat me down in front of a potter's wheel and let me play with a lump of clay. Then, he took me and my sister to the MSC, and we scooted around in roller skates and had a grand time. I had such positive association with Graceland, it was hard to even imagine going anywhere else."

HER STUDENT EXPERIENCE In 1989, Skinner was recruited to Graceland, along with her twin sister, Ruth, to run cross country and track. Then head coach Terry Yee told the twins he wanted to grow the program, and they had just what he was looking for to bring excitement to his teams.

The sisters were placed on Amici house, despite early requests for Shalom. Marian Killpack told Skinner she had seen the twins at Spectacular, the

annual Community of Christ summer camp held on Graceland's Lamoni campus, and knew they had just the leadership skills she needed for Amici.

All these expectations may have been too much pressure for some 18 year olds, but Skinner didn't disappoint. She qualified for nationals in cross country that first year at Graceland — she and Ruth were the first women in Graceland's history — and by the time she was a sophomore, Skinner was a captain for the team. She ended up loving Amici and house life, and served as a house president her junior year; then she spent her senior year as Graceland's student government president. Not only had she impressed those around her, but she had also become deeply invested in Graceland and everything it stood for.

AFTER GRADUATION Skinner worked as the assistant coach for the track and cross country teams under Yee for seven years while she worked in a variety of other areas throughout the institution: the grant-funded Educational Talent Search program, career services, as a secretary for alumni programs... She got a lot of different exposure to a lot of offices around campus. "That coaching experience allowed for me to transition from athlete to leader; and the different roles I had around campus really helped me understand higher education in a holistic way."

When Skinner left Graceland and worked as a hall director for Fort Lewis College in Durango, Colorado, she had the opportunity to work in a public liberal arts institution much larger than Graceland. She could feel the difference in the community, but the experience offered her perspective.

The largest career shift for Skinner came when she entered law enforcement. However, it tapped into all the experiences she had gained to that point and put them into a different role as a civil servant. This experience was incredibly helpful when she returned to Graceland as director of residence life, because it gave her a true appreciation for Graceland's educational approach to student conduct.

So, after going out into the world with her Graceland education, returning to "the Hill" with new knowledge and experience seemed to be the most natural transition. "At no place that I ever worked did I appreciate and value the community and the mission as much as I do at Graceland," shared Skinner.

“I feel that people *need* Graceland more than they realize – that we fill a special niche in developing the human connection. So, the challenge is, how do you market Graceland so that every year, 350 young people who *need* it know that they *want* it?”

CALLING ALL ALUMNI Part of the answer has already shown itself to her through a glimpse of an impressive alumni network eager to help. Since she became dean of undergraduate admissions, Skinner has been flooded with phone calls, emails and people reaching out asking what they can do.

Dr. Roger '89 and Patty Wilkinson '89 Sacry and their two daughters, Isabella '20 and Gwyneth '22, moved to Carthage in 2004 when they found the cozy community checked all their boxes. "We've always loved small town," Roger said. "We liked the school system, and we liked that we were near a larger city."

Over the years, the Sacry family has established businesses in Carthage. Roger's private practice, Sacry Family Medicine, expanded in 2012 with a medical spa, The Pavilion.
