Every once in a while you get a phone call and it feels like someone punched you in the stomach. I was in Houston with my family on December 30 when I received a call informing me that Barbara Higdon had passed away.


I knew treatment had not been going well, but I still felt that punch in the stomach. I felt overwhelmed with grief and immediately thrust into another place in time. It is that highly meditative place, a place of respect and quiet repose. It is a place of prayer where you thank God that you knew this person. That was the way it was with me when I heard about Barbara's passing.

Barbara was a highly competent person. She always made a positive difference in everything she did. Her strength and compassion drove this university forward, as our first full-time woman president and as a true Gracelandian who always answered the call when she was needed.

One of the great things about Barbara was that you didn't have to wait until her death to celebrate her life. The differences she made every day were so profound that they inspired you to frequently celebrate her gifts to higher education, to the causes of peace and justice and her enduring love for Graceland.

In that special place in time, with my family in Houston, I paused and remembered being with Barbara in recent times and feeling that I was sitting near greatness. I celebrated that, even before she passed. Our president, Dr. John D. Sellars, likened the Graceland Forever campaign to "all of Graceland's stars

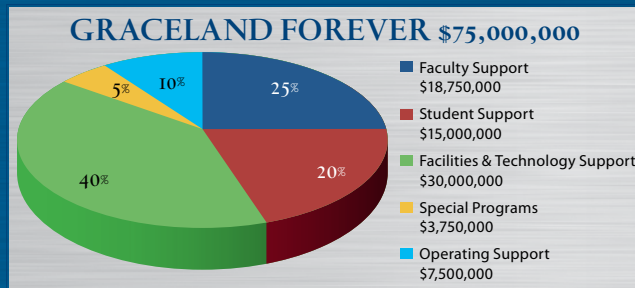

Made possible by a generous \$1.5 million gift from Janet Braun '61 and Bob Fitzgerald, "The Fitz" will do nothing short of transform how our students exercise, stay well and stay fit. Jan and Bob were on campus for Homecoming and the campaign launch. They are shown here posing in the bright October sun. Their son Randy '91 helped guide the fitness component of our committee to study replacing the MSC someday. Janet, Bob, Randy, daughters Robin '89 Long and Jenni Fitzgerald, the entire family's commitment to fitness, led to the decision to build a modern fitness center sooner than later. It was the Fitzgeralds who made that possible.

Students are at the forefront of "The Fitz." They worked with staff and administrators to choose equipment and amenities geared to today's students. A new fitness center was number one on students' wish list. Associate Professor Diane Bartholomew, who chairs the Fitz Center planning committee, is excited about how the facility will enhance classes in the Health and Movement Science Division. Dean of Students Marian Killpack can't say enough about how each student will benefit, each day. Enrollment Management VP Kirk Bjorland calls The Fitz one of our greatest new recruiting tools.

A new era of convenient health and fitness accessibility for our students is on its way, and that is exactly what the Fitzgerald family had in mind. Robert Fitzgerald, not an alumnus, but a Graceland through and through, said his family's lives improved dramatically when they became more active a few years ago. A 21st Century campus, stunning new buildings, outstanding programs – none of it matters unless we meet our enrollment mark for the future. Ken told those gathered how critical it is for all of us, all Gracelanders, to be on the lookout for students who want to consider Graceland. “I have no doubt we will reach our optimal size, 1200-1400 students,” he said. “It is a very achievable goal. So, reach out and let us know, and tell us about students you have in mind. This is so critical. Never forget your alma mater when you speak with people at your jobs, on an airplane, in your congregations. You can make such a difference.”

Four wonderful students spoke at the launch and demonstrated, to the crowd’s delight, the reason we all love Graceland: we love our students – always have, always will. Take new students Sari and Dori Bosnyak, twins from Hungary who told their story with a humor that wowed us all; and Jonathan Bowman, who explained the importance of Campus Ministries and the SIFE team to his GU experience; and the exuberant Shay Eskridge, a 2011 grad who has returned to help coach women’s soccer. “Families I’ve never met made it possible for me to attend GU,” she said. “The importance of providing scholarship support is so very important.”

JR ‘56 and Carol Shaw are not only transforming the Shaw to a new level of beauty and function that will be the envy of universities throughout the region. With the single largest gift in Graceland history – \$14 million – they are positioning Graceland to join nationally-known, fine arts-focused universities like Luther College in Iowa, Concordia College in Minnesota and Oberlin College in Ohio. And, most importantly, the Shaws are creating a stunning space for our students to enjoy and relax in, to explore their passions in, and to grow and learn in.

Lee Bash, Special Consultant for GU Visual and Performing Arts, captures the importance of the Shaw transformation in this way: “It will strengthen our commitment to the liberal arts and enhance our focus on the visual and performing arts. It is then that Graceland will identify its commitment to excellence and provide a world-class venue for quality performances.”

to attend Graceland, to have that opportunity. That is priority number one! Endowed scholarships are a unique and meaningful way for you to get involved. President Sellars says that nothing makes his heart swell with pride more than to hear the stories about young people who are at Graceland because alumni and friends stepped up to make it possible. He said, "These are powerful testimonies, the kinds of stories that have been taking place on 'the Hill' for a hundred years."

We are partnering with Community of Christ members with the new 'Study and Faith' scholarships. Nearly 50 first-year-students entered Graceland last fall because of these tremendous scholarships that make GU very affordable.

We also need continued campus technology upgrades, like the recent, dramatic internet bandwidth upgrades funded by alumnus Joel '79 and Kathy Ross; we need increased funding for our very popular Winter Terms, the growing academic Honors Program, GU's National Champion SIFE team and internships.

University leaders and the board of trustees have labored to develop a strategic plan that will position Graceland for success. When a university begins a major campaign, like *Graceland Forever*, it provides the resources to make the strategic plan possible. According to President Sellars, "A strategic plan is only words and hope unless you have the money to make it happen. A cost-driven strategic plan is exciting because it actually *becomes* our campaign!"

In his office, in early January, our president says, "At the vortex where a strong strategic plan meets with a passionately-planned capital campaign, something magical happens. Our alumni and friends, people who are al-

ready living their dreams of making the world better, join the effort to give our young people of today the chance to live their own dreams of making the world better. It is indeed magical. It culminates when all those involved achieve their dreams. This is why Graceland exists."

On our Independence Campus (IC) the campaign will touch so many lives. We are seeing a dramatic expansion of the Edmund J. Gleazer School of Education on-line and on-site programs. The School of Nursing is innovative and strong. They have launched an exciting new postgraduate Doctor of Nursing Practice program that is attracting national attention. Nursing School Dean Claudia Horton '86 noted at the launch ceremony that 1,200 students are enrolled (400 online and 800 on site) on our IC.

Steve Anders '73, Dean of our C.H. Sandage School of Business, waxed poetic about Charles H. Sandage '23, whose vision and support helped create our diverse offering of business majors known across the country, our renowned SIFE team, and the entrepreneurial environment on our campuses.

Stew McDole '65, GU educator and coach for more than 30 years, eloquently reminded those gathered of the importance of a liberal arts education. "I didn't get it 40 years ago," he said. "Students don't get it now. But, a liberal arts education helps you make the decisions that enable life-changing transformations. I get that now. Our students will get it, too, later in life, when they need it most!"

Now is the time to join our mission. Our stars are in alignment. Let us "draw the space between heaven and earth just a bit closer."■

Barbara Higdon 1930-2011

She Lived for Family, Peace and Justice and

Her smile compelled you to smile back. When you spoke with her the sparkle in her eyes made you feel valued. She was interested in *everything*. Jazz made her want to dance. Her intelligence and leadership and grace and beauty and style empowered Graceland University to shine brightly for generations.

Barbara J. McFarlane Higdon, Graceland's first full-time woman president, passed away peacefully December 30, 2011, after a two-year battle with breast cancer. She was 81 years old.

Barbara devoted her life to family, issues of peace and social justice, church and spirituality, and above all, education. Together these themes weave a tapestry of a life well lived.

Barbara was Graceland's 13th president, serving from April 16, 1984 to December 31, 1991. She was known as an innovative leader and as a president who was not afraid to make tough decisions. Her leadership helped guide Graceland College out of a serious enrollment slump in the 1980s. She also led two capital campaigns that raised significant funds for the college. She achieved another first in 1986 when she and legendary Graceland educator Velma Ruch became the first women to be ordained to the RLDS priesthood on campus.

As Graceland president, Barbara also began student exchanges with Hungary and Bulgaria, she helped launch the Chance Program and she directed the application of a \$3 million federal grant that brought modern computer technology to campus. She helped initiate the Outreach Nursing Program, now recognized as one of the best in the country, and she developed our Center for the Study of Free Enterprise and Entrepreneurship.

Barbara entered Graceland College as a student in 1947 and became a student leader active in campus life, serving as president of the Crescents, writing for student publications and acting in college plays. She protested against recognized student social groups to which only invited

students were included. She majored in speech communications and received the gold seal for scholarship.

Barbara was a 1949 Graceland graduate. She married William T. Higdon (also a 1949 Graceland graduate, who served as Graceland president from 1966 to 1974 and from 1992 to 1997) in 1950.

In 1963, the Higdon family returned to Graceland as faculty members. Barbara was a respected professor of language and literature classes here until 1975. She inspired generations of students with her honesty, compassion and intellectual rigor. At Barbara's wonderful (and jazz filled) 'Celebration of Life' service January 7 in Lamoni, former student Kathy Olson '73 Sharp painted a memorable portrait of a teacher who touched the life of every student who entered her classroom.

Barbara loved this university, revered its history and believed in its future. After she and Bill built their home and retired to the country west of Lamoni, she continued to serve Graceland whenever and wherever she was called upon. Her efforts, and those of others, led to creation of the Community of Christ Seminary at Graceland

in 2001. She served as Seminary Provost for its first year and helped develop its curriculum.

In 2006 Barbara joined the Board of Trustees where she served on the Academic Affairs committee, a position she held until the end of her life. She had received Graceland's highest alumni honor, the Distinguished Service Award, in 1995.

Many friends of both Barbara and Graceland have chosen to honor her memory with the Barbara Higdon Memorial Endowment. Gifts to the endowment will support the university's mission, a fitting tribute to a life-long Graceland graduate. A Seminar on Peace and memorial celebration to honor Barbara is to be held May 18, 2012 on our Lamoni campus. Everyone is invited to attend. It would have been her 82nd birthday.

All Gracelanders thank you, Barbara, for a legacy of loving leadership that few have, or ever will, equal. ■

GRACELAND SHINES BRIGHTER: BECAUSE OF OUR 2011 ALUMNI AWARD RECIPIENTS

The Graceland Alumni Association presented their awards at the 12th Annual Alumni Emeriti & Awards Banquet at Homecoming 2011. **Lucienna Wismer Jones** of Amherstburg, Ontario, Canada received one of two Honorary Alumni Awards. Lucienna has been providing her special gift of music for both young and old since she was 13 years old. She was actually the congregational music director at that



tender age for a small country church in Ontario. The oldest in a family of six, she was born with a number of great talents and gifts that she has generously shared over the years.

Lucienna was third in her ninth grade class when hard times forced her from the classroom to a field hand job on the family farm. But that didn't stop her love of learning and

music. She enrolled in correspondence courses covering disciplines that her friends were studying in high school. Her talent and hard work at the piano led to an Associate Royal Conservatory Teacher degree from the Royal Conservatory Music program in Canada.

She has shared her talent – always with that special 'Lucienna smile' – at hundreds of Community of Christ related events, including reunions and church services. When this snow bird migrates to Florida in the winter, she still makes the rounds with her electronic keyboard in tow to play at neighborhood community centers.

Jones raised three children who attended Graceland. She has been very supportive of Canadian students eager to trade the sprawling fields of Ontario for the expansive corn fields of southern Iowa. Asked why she gives so generously to help students get to Graceland, she replied sincerely, "It is very important to me that they have the opportunity I did not have."

Thank you Lucienna for helping so many Canadian students realize the dream of a 'Graceland Experience.' Keep that song in your heart, your fingers on the keys, and welcome to the ranks of Graceland alumni.

Love was a detour in **Colleen Brooner's** journey toward becoming a Graceland alumna. In 1953, with a new high school diploma, she was ready to head off to begin her college career when a good-looking Graceland student captured her heart. He thought she was pretty special as well, and so instead of becoming a GU student, she became Mrs. Orman Brooner in a double wedding with her sister. They were married on a beautiful Saturday night in June, and Orman was back at his

new job the next Monday morning.

Colleen developed a love for Graceland and she encouraged two sisters, Orman, and four children to attend Graceland. Most of her grandchildren have also attended Graceland. Says Colleen: "It was important to me for our kids to attend Graceland because I wanted the best for them. I wanted them to be in a good environment where they could associate with others who would share some of the same beliefs and values."

Over the years Colleen has proven herself again and again to be a true Graceland. Along with Orman, a member of the GU Board of Trustees, Colleen has supported many GU programs, and the students she loves. Perhaps no time typified Colleen's affection for Graceland more than when she and Orman accompanied (on the bus, in the plane, and everywhere around the city) our national champion SIFE team to the world championships in Paris, where they finished second to China in 2006.

When asked about attaining honorary alumna status, Colleen said, "Never in my wildest dreams would I have imagined becoming honorary alumni. This is such a great honor and I feel that I am not deserving of it."

Faculty and fellow students who knew **Jim Ash** '78 as a student at Graceland back in the late 70's recognized the awesome potential he had – as a



friend, as a successful professional and as a community leader. Jim exceeded everyone's expectation, in every category.

After graduating from UCLA Law School with honors, he returned to Kansas City where he began working as a corporate lawyer specializing in securities law, and mergers and acquisitions. In 1993 Jim joined Husch Blackwell LP and in 2000 became the chair of the firm's corporate department.

In 2008 Jim became Chairman of the Business Services Division where he manages nine separate departments with 350 attorneys. Since 2008 he's also served as Senior

Vice President and Chief Legal Counsel for H&R Block, managing the legal government relations departments along with the 'tax institute' for the Fortune 500 Company.

Jim has been recognized time and time again by his peers for his outstanding work: Missouri Super Lawyer; Best Lawyers in America; Chambers Leading Lawyers in America; Law Dragon Top 500 U.S. Attorneys; and most recently, Jim was named 2010 Kansas City Corporate Lawyer of the Year.

The Typical Experience

In a typical collegiate athletic experience, athletes are often viewed as commodities by their coaches and are expected to perform on the field or court and to practice hard in the off-season. Often, the relationship ends there.

An athlete's education is reserved for teachings of professors and reading the many books required to pass the course. Often, coaches defer the responsibility of educating an athlete, instead focusing on athletic performance. Coaches diligently prepare for games, watch hours of video and recruit for months to better next year's squad.

So where do athletics and academics actually converge into a meaningful experience? They often don't, and some say universities are churning out student-athletes in record numbers, unprepared for the real world.

Yellowjacket athletics is anything but typical.

The Graceland Difference

What exactly is a liberal arts education? A university that requires its students to take core courses in an array of academic disciplines? When it comes to athletics, Graceland University applies a different approach.

"What we're doing here is producing leadership and stewardship skills," veteran head women's volleyball coach Stew McDole '65 said. "These are lessons that need to be developed outside the classroom and off the athletic fields."

Graceland athletics is incorporating community service into the intercollegiate athletic experience for its student-athletes. McDole believes this is a great opportunity.

"Our athletes dedicate so many hours to practicing and honing their skills, while balancing a demanding academic schedule. Serving our community is an opportunity to develop characteristics that these athletes can carry with them into the real world. These are life skills that aren't theoretical, but applied in nature."

A Liberal Arts Athletic Experience

Graceland University players and coaches are uniting in an effort to partake in the larger mission of Graceland University – to create well-rounded citizens who positively impact their communities. The athletic department is committed to the mission of the university, and the results are reflected in the prestigious award Yellowjacket

athletics received last year from the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), the governing body of Graceland athletics.

GU was named a Champions of Character Five-Star Institution by the NAIA. Few institutions meet the strict criteria, which require documented, tangible proof that the student-athletes are excelling in five main areas of character: integrity, respect, responsibility, sportsmanship and servant leadership.

The first four criteria concern on-the-field character. The last criterion is the student-athletes' responsibility to others, and to the community. Graceland athletes can impact others' lives and develop servant leadership skills – critical to success in the workplace.

Adopt-A-Highway

McDole's volleyball squad has adopted a stretch of highway between the Sale Barn and I-35. Each year, the team removes trash and debris along the road. According to McDole, the players have really begun to learn team building and communication skills while keeping up the road into Lamoni.

Approach to a Liberal Arts Education

"You should see the amounts of trash we actually pick up," McDole said. "The way the ladies organize and communicate to do the work effectively is very impressive. By the time we are all done, we've filled dozens of trash bags. They end up standing tall."

Players have even gone above and beyond, like junior outside hitter Kaylee Miller. "I've been driving in my car and noticed a piece of trash. I just had to pick it up. I wondered, 'Who threw trash on my road'? It drove me crazy to see it dirty."

It is through these experiences that coach McDole is certain his graduates will make great contributions wherever their lives may lead them.

For Love of the Game

Every fall, the men's and women's soccer programs volunteer their time to run weekly soccer practices for kids of all ages in the Lamoni area. While it takes a toll on their down time during the season, women's head coach Fred Wagenaar recognizes the importance of ministering to the kids. "It's great to show the up-coming generation the best of what sports can teach about sharing, selflessness and dedication."

Men's head coach Guillermo Sanchez '06 said that while sometimes it is difficult to run the camps in season, his players see the fruits of their labor, as does the community. "Most of the kids at our camps have no soccer experience. We try to teach them respect for the game and ultimately, how to have fun through the vehicle of sport. We make sure all the kids score and the smiles on their faces say it all."

Sanchez also recognized the importance of his players mentoring the kids. "A lot of these kids come from broken homes. It's a valuable lesson in humility for our students. Even in a short time, we're impacting lives for the good."

While recalling the difficulty of homework, games, practice and work his players have to balance, the second-year head coach only has to remember one special encounter. "There was one boy in particular. He came from bad circumstances and didn't have much to get excited about. After seven weeks with our athletes, he is now totally in love with the game of soccer."

Wagenaar agreed. "Soccer is a passion for this team, but it's certainly clear that their hearts are big enough to go far beyond the soccer pitch."

In Remembrance

The men's and women's tennis programs have a soft spot in their hearts for Helen Russell '52 Hampton, the late wife of Jerry Hampton '52, a Graceland educator/coach for more than 50 years. Helen succumbed to cancer in 1997. The tennis squads work at the Des Moines *Race for the Cure*, an annual event to honor Helen. It is the largest

cancer run in the nation, organized by the Hampton family. The student athletes have a large task on their hands: carting water to the finish line for the participants. "We're not talking about a few cases of water," said a proud head coach Monroe Walker. "We are hauling pallets of water for the largest run in the country. More importantly, we couldn't be more proud and humbled to do it."

One could see the gratification in Walker's eyes. They glowed as he spoke of the opportunity to serve a wonderful cause while also paying tribute to Coach Hampton's late wife. "I want my athletes to understand the world is much bigger than tennis. We need to realize that helping others is an expression of faith and hope. We need to be thankful for our health and help others that are not as fortunate."

A Team Contribution

Each program gives back in its own way, whether it be the baseball team keeping up Chase Stadium for community use, the dance team training young athletes in the art of dance, the men's volleyball team weeding and doing yard work at the public library, or the golf teams readying the golf course every season. "By giving back, I hope it instills a sense of pride in my players that they have had the opportunity to make a difference," said head baseball coach Brady McKillip '00.

"It could be just one child's life or an entire middle school and high school by giving them a quality field to play on. I also want my players to understand that it is the right thing to do; when the moment arrives, make a difference by helping out. This sets a precedent so when they leave Graceland, it is a habit and it translates into servant leadership wherever they end up."

Athletic Director Jeff Falkner echoed McKillip's sentiments. "It's our way of serving the university and fulfilling its mission. Servant leadership is the cornerstone to not only athletic success by serving one's fellow athletes, but serving the greater good of every person an athlete comes in contact with, whether in school or on the job. We couldn't be more proud of our student athletes as they serve the university and the community."

Falkner added, "They truly are champions of character."■



Women's Soccer Team Leads Graceland

The women's soccer program, in the 11th hour, found itself invited to the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) national championships, despite their 9-6-4 record. The Jackets received the at-large bid due to our high Modified Ratings Percentage Index. GU faced the most difficult schedule in the nation.

The Jackets were pitted against Concordia University at Irvine (California), a first-time participant in NAIA post-season play, in part due to the difficult competition in the Golden State Athletic Conference.

Graceland made its way to sunny California with one purpose in mind: prove to the nation it belonged in its fourth consecutive postseason appearance.

The GU defense stepped up quickly as the Concordia Eagles played the Jackets hard for 110 minutes from start to finish. GU's Stefany Castano Cardozo was ready for a fierce, relentless Eagle attack.

"It's my job to direct the defense and stay focused every minute of the match," said the sophomore keeper after her 13-save shutout of the 10th-ranked Eagles. The GU keeper had to do just that, as the host squad constantly beat GU in loose ball control and total time of possession.

The Eagles would continually choreograph elaborate runs and crosses, designed to confuse the GU back line. Castano Cardozo made four difficult saves in the first half look routine. She is among the most athletic goaltenders in the nation.

The Eagles came out a determined bunch in the second half, quickly moving the ball around the perimeter, feeding passes into the box and getting in the way of Castano Cardozo. However, the sophomore, All-HAAC goalkeeper wouldn't let this phase her as she made another five saves during the second half, finishing regulation play with nine.

Graceland had to fend off pressure during extra time, but again, Castano Cardozo came up big. In the 96th minute, an Eagle attacker found the ball at her feet about nine yards away from the GU goal. At the last moment,



the Graceland net minder dove straight up in the air, just deflecting the ball over the crossbar. Again, the Jackets had escaped defeat.

In the final moments, Graceland knew it had an opportunity to win the game in a shootout. Each GU player stepped up with the confidence of a veteran, and they took advantage of an Eagle goalkeeper who saw little action during the match. Gisela Arrieta, Daniela Gonzalez, Karina Vega and Leslie Carroll all scored for GU and Castano Cardozo came up with a huge save, leaving the fate of the match on the foot of GU's Ainsley Nagora. After the first four GU shooters went right, Nagora went left. The Eagle goalkeeper guessed correctly, extending the shootout. After the Eagles scored their final opportunity, the match moved to a sudden-death penalty kick scenario.

The match only went one more round as Sarahi Ortiz Casillas buried her chance, going right again. As the pres-

sure mounted and the Jackets smelled victory, the Eagles sent a final shot wide right and the GU reserves and coaching staff stormed the field. Graceland had proved what they came to prove.

"It was an outstanding defensive effort by the whole team," said head coach Fred Wagenaar. "Our back four were disciplined, organized and communicated well. Stefany did an amazing job handling the shots that did get through. We had lost not once, but twice in the 2010 postseason, so it felt very good finding ourselves on the winning side for once."

Graceland advanced to Mobile, Alabama to the main tournament site a week later. However, the dreary weather conditions and potent offense of the University of Mobile Rams sent the Jackets back to Lamoni. GU finished among the final 16 teams in the country. Considering that 192 NAIA institutions field women's soccer teams, Graceland

viewed the 2011 campaign as a tremendous success, highlighted by the selections of Gisela Arrieta and Karina Vega to the All-American list as honorable mentions.

Cross Country Star Mebrahtu Finishes Strong

Also making a National Tournament appearance was men's cross country runner Yonas Mebrahtu.

Facing a field of 311 fellow runners at the Fort Vancouver Historic Site in Vancouver, Washington, Mebrahtu finished in 13th place, solidifying his second-straight All-American honor and besting his 19th place finish from 2010.

"I'm happy with the way I ran today, despite the difficulties I experienced with my shoe and my shin," said Mebrahtu after the run. "I had to fight really hard at the end to catch back up with the pack and finish where I did."

Yonas was 1 minute, 15 seconds behind the impressive winning time by Wayland Baptists' Kennedy Kithuka, but he did lead all HAAC runners in Vancouver.



Tennis Teams are Successful Again

Two tennis players also qualified for the ITA national event in Mobile, Alabama with wins in their respective matches. Laurentsi Arakhamiya won the 'A flight' of the men's grouping by defeating Jack Schoeman of Bethany College, 6-2, 6-2.



On the women's side, Tatiana Varela Fontecha defeated Elanqua Griffin of Missouri Valley College to qualify for the ITA finals. Fontecha won in an exciting, 7-5, 6-4 match. ■


help everyone in the community stay connected. It's a great time to be joining the Graceland team."

Graceland University's own Dr. Kevin Prine '86 has been named the new President and Chief Executive Officer of Outreach International, the Independence, MO-based charity dedicated to breaking the cycle of extreme poverty around the world.

Long time GU educator and architect of Graceland's internationally-prominent Students in Free Enterprise (SIFE) team, Kevin was chosen as the new president following a rigorous nationwide search. He has overall responsibility for the leadership and management of Outreach International (OI), a \$3.5 million international humanitarian organization working in 13 countries worldwide. OI was founded in 1979.

Kevin began teaching at GU in 1990, consistently garnering student evaluations in the top one percent in the country. He was popularly known by his students as the teacher who encouraged them to "think big". He won the prestigious Graceland Excellence in Teaching Award in 1997.

Kevin departed Graceland to become Chair of Business and Leadership at William Jewell College in Liberty, MO, and most recently he served as part of the management team at Tradebot Systems & Tradebot Ventures in Kansas City, Missouri.

About his new challenge at OI, Kevin said, "This is an amazing opportunity, and I am honored and humbled. I have witnessed firsthand Outreach International's powerful and sustainable approach to transforming impoverished communities. I recognize the extraordinary mutually-transformative power when those born in abundance compassionately partner with those born in poverty, and I am eager to lead the organization to greater growth and even greater impact."

There is an active OI Club at Graceland. Each year, through activities and events, they have raised significant funds to help OI further its cause of sustainability in impoverished areas. Max Pitt, Professor of Business Administration and Agricultural Business in the C.H. Sandage School of Business, is GU sponsor of our OI club and a member of the OI Board of Trustees. He said, "Kevin's appointment to OI will add a synergy to the mission of human development between our two organizations."

GRACELAND *after* DARK





Creatively photographing Graceland's Lamoni campus is an ongoing challenge, especially during these times of exciting construction. Gracelanders like to see images of what is happening on campus, and they enjoy seeing our students involved in their many activities and events.

We all know, however, that sometimes you have to step outside the box. So, student staff photographers Michael Montanez and Rahmana Schooler and I experimented last semester to capture a different look: *Graceland after Dark*. You see the

results here, and on the cover.

There are a number of methods of capturing night shots: long exposure times, using slow shutter speeds to create the feeling of movement, or by simply using a flash. What you're looking at here is called High Dynamic Range (HDR) photography. The human eye forgives a lot, making adjustments so fast that we don't even notice. When a single photo is taken, however, the camera must meter off of one thing at a time. By using HDR, we are able to create the ideal photo as if the camera lens were as intuitive as the human eye.

Each photo you see here is a combination of six-to-10 photos, taken with use of a tripod, at different levels of exposure – from three stops underexposed to three stops overexposed. When joined together these photos create a painterly effect that we think captures the beauty of *Graceland after Dark*.

My daughter Shelby recently received her acceptance to Graceland. This was a matter of great pride for my family. Shelby is our youngest child and our sixth child to attend Graceland.

Shelby also qualified for a generous scholarship. When she announced her acceptance and scholarship to her classmates, most students reacted positively but passively. One, however, reacted fiercely. "Shelby, why do you get everything?" he said. "You don't need a scholarship. I do. I'll never get a scholarship and I'm going to have a terrible life."

When I heard that story my heart sunk. How many potential students are out there who would benefit from a Graceland education? How many kids who have lost hope about their future would have their lives transformed by the 'Graceland Experience'?

Our current enrollment on the Lamoni campus is about 1,000 students. It's about 2,400 university-wide, including online students and the Independence campus.

We believe that an additional 200 students on the Lamoni campus would be optimal. That means we have

the capacity to transform 200 lives if we could just reach those kids that are searching for this unique opportunity.

Last year we instituted the 'Study and Faith' scholarship program to ensure that Community of Christ students can afford to attend Graceland. Community of Christ members attending the Lamoni campus are guaranteed scholarships that equal at least 50 percent of the amount of tuition. We are currently examining the program to determine whether it can be expanded to include other exceptional students who are known to members of Graceland's Board of Trustees.

But that won't help Shelby's friend. Taking matters into our own hands, we approached him and offered to submit his application to Graceland. We are waiting on his response.

How many student-age kids do you know that are still trying to make their minds up about which university or college to attend? Talk to them. See what they think about Graceland. Maybe they would like to know more about life on "the Hill" and the great education they can expect at Graceland. Please provide their contact information to the Graceland Admissions Office.

JR Shaw was on campus recently and it was fun to watch him tour the construction site with the architects and



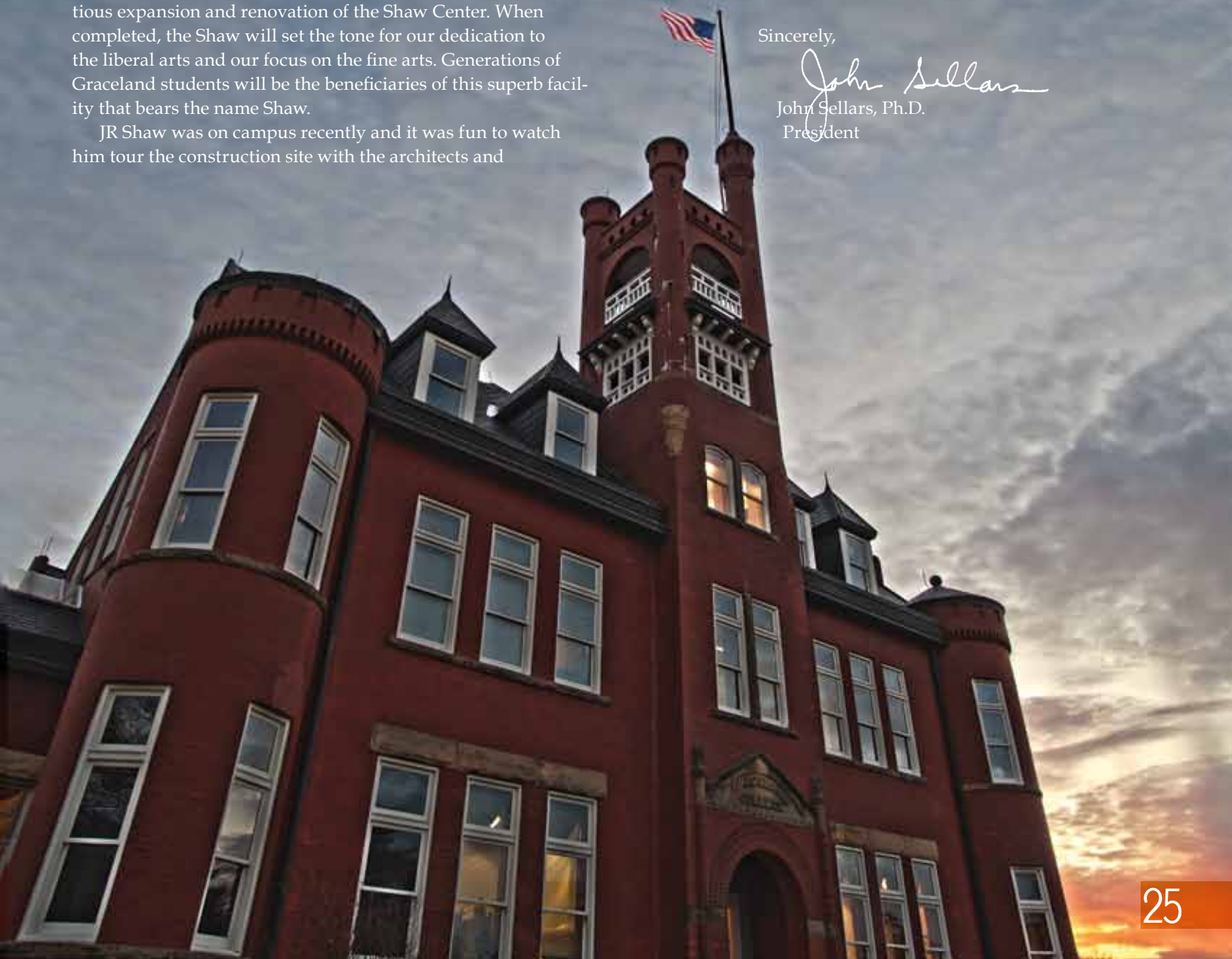

Thank you all for making this a year I will never forget. I am humbled to be your president.

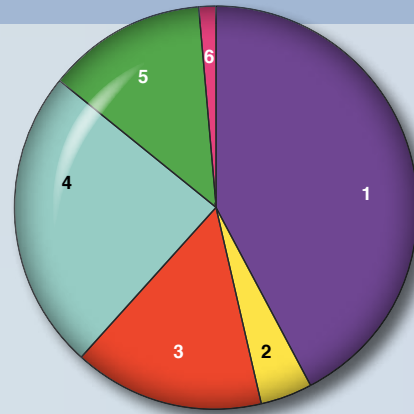

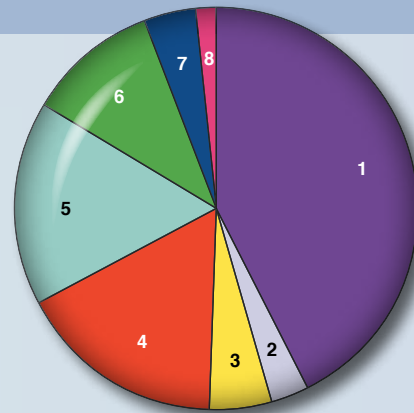
