

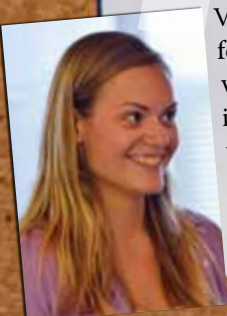
Braden Austin,

Oscar Chang,

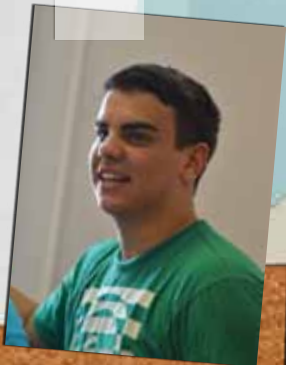
majoring in sports management and computer science, is from Malaysia.

New Programs — New Faces



Bowling

Bowling is one of the most popular, fastest-growing collegiate sports in the country. In 2013, Graceland jumped on the bandwagon and added bowling to its roster of varsity sports. The program is headed by longtime Lamoni Demons bowling coach Doug Zimmerman, who was instrumental in establishing bowling as a viable sport in high schools across the state of Iowa.

Leon, Iowa native Kilee Petty '17 was on the bowling team throughout high school, averaging 160 to 180 points per game. Now a biology and chemistry major at Graceland, she says the bowling program is what brought her to Lamoni. "I was going to go to Clarke University in Dubuque to bowl, but Graceland offered more scholarship opportunities," said Kilee. "I'm excited to see which schools we're going to bowl against and how the new program is going to work."

Drumline

Drumline is a new fall 2013 program at Graceland University, led by Dr. Adam Groh. Dr. Groh and his students are excited to begin a new tradition of drumline performances that build excitement, team spirit, and Yellowjacket pride.



Allysha Bilges '17, an Oklahoma native majoring in music and technical theatre, said her whole family has gone to Graceland, yet coming to Lamoni was "a last-minute decision to get out and fly away from the house." Allysha is following many Community of Christ friends to Iowa from her home state. Allysha plays the trap sets and tuba, but is most excited to play the bass drum—or "Big Mama," as she calls it.



Elliott Vilmain '17 of Pleasantville, Iowa, came to the Graceland campus as a high school student for drama workshops and honor choir. When Dr. Perez asked him if he'd like to join the drumline, "I said, 'Why not?' It sounded fun," said Elliott, who plays the snare and bass drum. "Hopefully, we'll inspire more people to join drumline and get interested in music."



Westley Huey '17 is a biology major and Louisiana native. He has family and friends who have gone to Graceland and is a Community of Christ member. When Dr. Groh recruited him to play mallets for the new drumline program, Westley was excited to become one of the first Gracelanders starting a new tradition of percussion performance. Wrestling

For the first time since 1982, Graceland has wrestlers on its campus again! After a 31-year hiatus, wrestling has been reinstated as a varsity sport at Graceland, and Demond Jennings '15 (left) and Fuad Salomon '17 are here to restore glory to the program.

Demond Jennings '15 is a transfer from Arkansas Baptist College, where he was captain of the wrestling team. For Demond, Graceland's storied wrestling past was a major draw to the reinstated program. "The coach told me about the program — how Graceland had never lost a conference championship — and I decided I wanted to be a part of that legacy," said Demond.

Fuad Salomon '17, a computer science and business administration major from Orlando, Fla., heard about Graceland University from a Graceland-bound cousin planning to play football as a freshman. "Being a part of the new wrestling program definitely adds to the excitement of being new on campus," said Fuad, who is finding that the quiet small-town atmosphere of Lamoni helps him focus on his career and studies.

Fitzgerald Fitness Center

Located on the northwest end of campus just south of Tess Morgan, the Fitz, named for donors Bob and Janet (Braun) '61 Fitzgerald, has been a part of the Graceland landscape since September 16, 2012. With the opening of the Fitz, Graceland celebrated a new era of student health and wellness on "the Hill." The Fitz is a state-of-the-art facility with more than \$150,000 in exercise equipment, including aerobic machines outfitted with personal viewing screens, a full circuit of strength-and-fitness equipment, and small, functional training pieces.

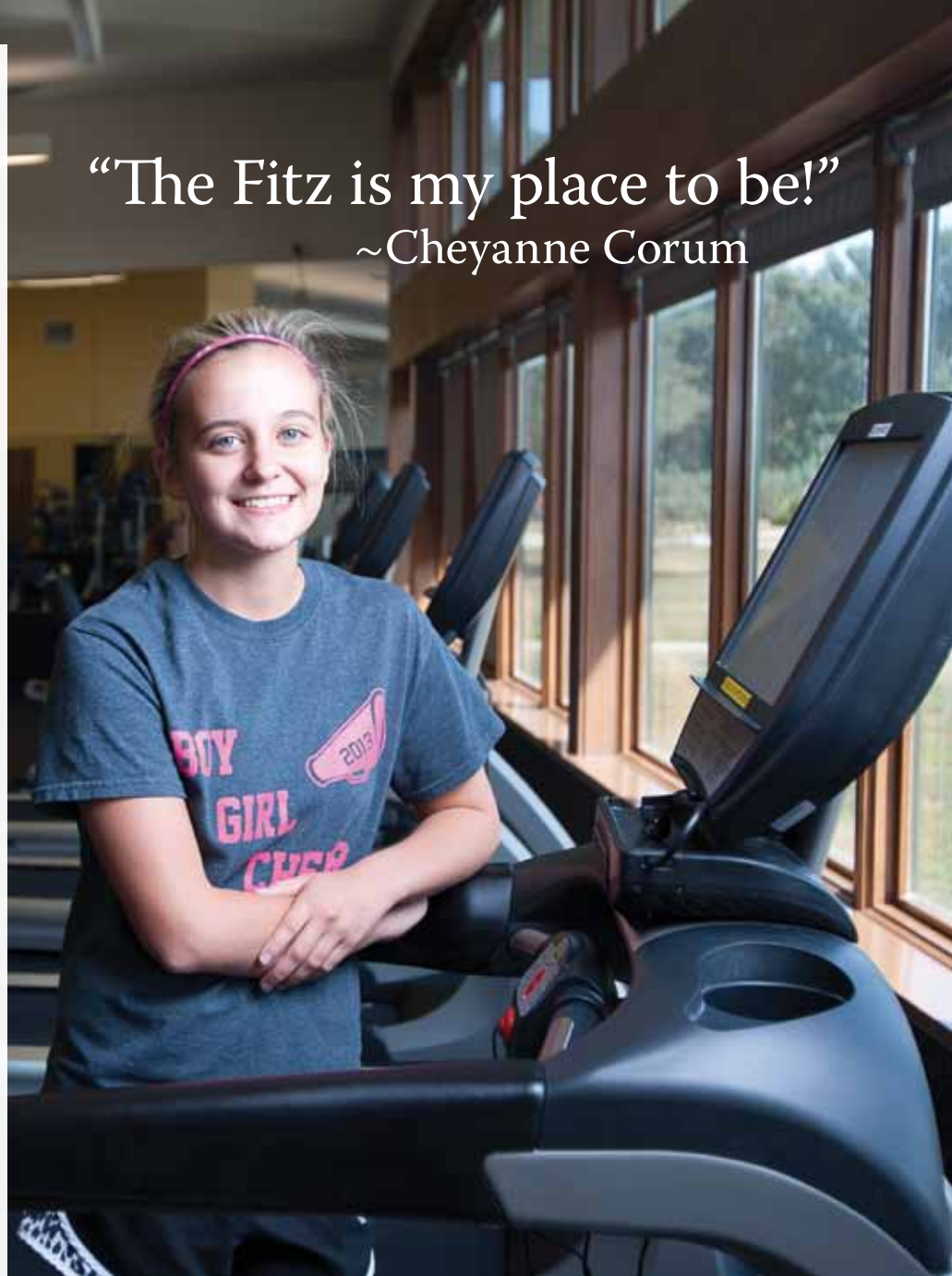

Graceland University Hoop House Project

What is a Hoop House?

Graceland University's Sustainability Office recently completed the installation of a Hoop House for the primary purpose of growing food for campus. Hoop houses, also commonly referred to as high tunnels, are covered, passive solar-heated structures, designed to extend the growing season and intensify production of crops. They provide a protected environment which can help grow higher quality produce at higher yields. The structure can be seen on the northeast corner of Graceland University's Lamoni campus. The Graceland Hoop House structure was made possible by a donation from alumni Jeanne Upson and Steve Upson and the Noble Foundation for which Mr. Upson works as a horticulture consultant (Please see "Other noteworthy contributors to the Hoop House

installation" at the end of this article). The Hoop House is part of a growing sustainability program that continues to demonstrate its importance to the students, alumni, Lamoni community, and the broader Graceland family.

Raising Beds and Raising Funds

In order to plant crops in the most favorable composted soil, eight raised beds were built in the Hoop House. Vegetables like tomatoes, peppers, cucumbers and beans will be grown in the garden. These vegetables will be harvested and sold to Sodexo services so that the produce can be used in meals prepared in the Commons for the campus community. Students will have access to fresh produce and experience for themselves what local

(remarkably fresh!) tastes like. Remaining harvested vegetables will be sold or donated to businesses and members of the Lamoni community.

In order to help irrigate the Hoop House, the Sustainability Office hopes to raise funds to bring an irrigation system to the Hoop House by extending the irrigation system used for the practice soccer fields. This will save time and money by allowing the Hoop House to be more easily watered by our student workers assigned to this particular Sustainability project.

Other Hoop House benefactions need to be "unearthed" to make the necessary purchases to guarantee the success and longevity of the project. Example materials that would make the Hoop House project more streamlined would be a mechanical tiller, wheelbarrows, extra gloves, rakes and hoes for volunteers, and a toolshed, just to name a few.

Campus as Classroom

Artist Betsy Cañas Garmon has it right, “My garden is my favorite teacher.” Like the new outdoor campus amphitheater, the Hoop House also exists to provide an educational landscape that lacks the confines of the traditional classroom setting. Students will not only learn to grow their own food, but they will learn what it means to actively engage in more sustainable production and consumption habits by seeing their own produce used locally. By bringing students outside of the traditional classroom, they garner the therapeutic benefits of being outside and being an active participant in the southern Iowa landscape. They’ll see first-hand the ecosystem to which they and Graceland belong.

The larger vision of the Hoop House Project is for the structure to become a part of a larger Demonstration Homestead: A parcel of campus that will serve to model how Graceland and Lamoni community members can subsist from a quarter or half acre of land. Not many other colleges in the nation are doing this. Not many other colleges in the nation *can* do this. Graceland University can



take advantage of its natural agricultural surroundings, differentiate itself among other liberal arts universities, and build a curriculum to take advantage of this opportunity. It will be valuable for students to leave Graceland with a skillset that will give them the confidence to nourish themselves and their families using a small plot of land. Encouraging our students to think ecologically about themselves and the places they will inhabit outside of the comfortable ecosystem that is Graceland campus begins with realigning students’ relationship with nature to something that is perhaps more personal. Making full use of our exterior campus resources to establish or re-establish these student-nature relationships is what this Demonstration Homestead could inspire.



Beyond the Hoop House: Other Campus Sustainability Projects

The list of campus sustainability programs and projects continues to grow. There is no shortage of ideas for how Graceland can become more sustainable in its operations. Beyond the Hoop House, the most recent additions to campus are the bike share program (made possible by the local Rotary Club); the new bike shelter located near the FITZ; vermicomposting bins for offices; reusable bag stations; and the popular student clothing swap program. As of mid-September, students have been regularly requesting that the Sustainability Office furnish more shared bikes for campus use. The goal is to acquire 10 additional bicycles to help expand the bike share program and fulfill student need. The Sustainability Office also plans to seek funding support in the future for the planning and implementation of renewable energy systems for campus.

SHAW Amphitheatre

When asked about the potential impact of the Shaw Center amphitheatre upon Graceland, Lee Bash noted how the amphitheatre “is a perfect example of how architecture changes a culture. Did you notice how prominent or central the amphitheatre was for Spectacular’s activities? When the drumline performs in the amphitheatre prior to home football games, it will begin

what will surely become a tradition where the entire community becomes more active prior to games. The Gadets will join the pre-game activities with Sting and the

cheerleaders and will make the entire area much more dynamic than ever before.

“But the other aspect that I find particularly appealing is what the Shaw amphitheatre implies — perhaps, demands — for the future. I envision Summer Performing Arts Series taking

place at the Shaw amphitheatre. This, it seems to me, has huge potential to impact not only Graceland, but Lamoni as well. When you see a series like this, you see a



large influx of customers that is going to impact Lamoni merchants as well. Will Graceland host either the Des Moines or Kansas City orchestra during the summer? We don’t know yet, but it feels inevitable to me that this is going to expand our mission, our identity, and our operation.”

Performing Arts series 2013-14

The 2013-2014 Performing Arts Series began September 22 with the Fountain City Brass Band as the Series opener. FCBB is followed by the Lakota Sioux Dance Theatre on November 18, Ladysmith Black Mambazo on February 13, 2014, and Massenkoff Russian Folk Festival on April 4, 2014. Performing Art Series tickets go on sale 30 days before each event.



Ladysmith Black Mambazo

On February 13, 2014 at 7:30 p.m., Ladysmith Black Mambazo comes to Graceland University to celebrate over fifty years of joyous and uplifting music that marries the intricate rhythms and harmonies of their native South African musical traditions to the sounds and sentiments of Christian gospel music. Led by founder Joseph Shabalala, the a cappella vocal group has created a musical and spiritual alchemy that has touched a worldwide audience representing every corner of the religious, cultural and ethnic landscape. Their musical efforts over the past five decades have garnered praise and accolades within the recording industry, but also solidified their identity as a cultural force to be reckoned with. In addition to their work with Paul Simon, Ladysmith Black Mambazo has recorded with numerous artists from around the world.

On April 4, 2014 at 7:30 p.m., the Massenkoff Russian Folk Festival will perform as the fourth and final act of the Performing Arts Series. In 1975, Nikolai Massenkoff founded the Massenkoff Russian Folk Festival, a festival of Russian music, song and dance expressing love for his Russian heritage. He has performed more than two decades both nationally and internationally to great acclaim. These performances included: Carnegie Hall; Olympic Stadium in Seoul, Korea before a live audience of 90,000 people; over 100 performances at the International Division of Epcot Center’s World Stage in Florida; with major symphony orchestras - San Francisco, Baltimore, Edmonton, Honolulu, Palm Beach, Flagstaff, London, Edmonton and Cincinnati Symphony; major performing arts centers; national and international television, including Suwestfunk (Baden, Baden, Germany) and the MGM Grand Hotel in Las Vegas.

The Man Behind The Scenes

What do the Wizard of Oz, the Director of the Shaw Center, and Technical Director, Jon Whatley, have in common? Each of them does his magic behind the scenes, but in Jon's case, the results are even more fantastic than the Wizard.

Jon came to Graceland about five years ago as a highly experienced and respected theatre technician/administrator. Graceland's growth and transformation in those five years have been dynamic, most notably with the new Shaw Center. Jon's role spans from the planning discussions to the applications he now oversees with the assistance of a small (6 – 10) team of student workers.

Since almost everything Jon does is behind the scenes, one of his most impressive skills is not obvious. He inspires and empowers his student workers. Jon's efforts provide a powerful dividend. After working with him these students are typically able to immediately obtain jobs in the technical theatre world.

After the 2012 Homecoming Grand Opening of the Shaw Center, Jon and his team have been remarkably busy. The new Shaw Center, with its JR Black Box Theatre, Carol Hall recital space, upgraded Shaw Family Theatre and new Shaw Amphitheatre ensure that there is an almost constant array of activities and responsibilities for Jon to oversee. These tasks start with scheduling but cover a myriad of details that require immense organization and attention. Each performer or group has unique technological needs (sound, lighting, recording, scenery, seating arrangements, dedicated rehearsal needs, pre- and post-performance details, including refreshments and other requirements such as makeup and dressing rooms). Juggling the time-consuming demands and pressure, Jon repeatedly demonstrates his dedication and commitment to the Shaw Center and Graceland.

In part, he attributes his dedication to how incredible the Shaw Center is: "All the performance and rehearsal spaces are far superior to almost all state institutions and it's amazing to find such an

impressive place located in Lamoni, Iowa. It is such a pleasure to work here together with these talented students as we strive to provide a truly professional experience for our audiences. When you have such incredible facilities, that objective is easier to achieve."

So the next time you attend a performance at the new Shaw Center, whether it's a Graceland student ensemble or production, or if it's part of the Performing Arts Series with the likes of the Vienna Boys Choir or Ladysmith Black Mambazo, take a moment to reflect on the work that Jon and his team have put into making this experience appear effortless. Jon's

dedication to the Shaw Center and Graceland will help ensure continued growth as a great University.

Diana C Tilton, MSN, RN

Diana Tilton graduated from St. Luke's School of Nursing, received her Bachelors of Science in Nursing from UMKC; and her Masters of Science in Nursing Education from UMKC. Diana joined the Graceland team in June of 2013 to teach in the BSN and the on-line RN-BSN program.

healthcare workplace environment. She specialized in Oncology/Hematology Nursing and Infusion nursing in the last 15 years of her career.

The highly regarded reputation of the Graceland nursing programs attracted Diana. "I was very impressed with the faculty during the interview process and felt

led to the development of accelerated Bachelors of Science in Nursing (BSN) programs for students with previous baccalaureate degrees in other disciplines. A new curriculum was developed for an accelerated BSN degree program that could be completed in 18 months.

Recognizing the need for flexible scheduling for registered nurses seeking degree completion, the RN-BSN program offered in a distance format was developed in 1987 and has enrolled nurses from all 50 states. In 1995, a Master's of Science in Nursing distance program was approved offering degrees in advanced practice nursing (Nurse Educator and Family Nurse Practitioner tracks). The post-master's Doctor of Nursing degree was added also in the online delivery format in the fall of 2012.

Seeking to offer cutting edge education to Graceland students, a human patient simulation lab was constructed which included three high-fidelity simulation manikins. The lab was funded by a grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration. Simulation offers a unique learning opportunity for students. The faculty creates patient care scenarios in which the students practice critical-thinking, clinical reasoning as well as hands on skills. Students are in a "safe" environment where they can enact the role of the nurse in decision making. After the simulation experience, students and faculty meet as a group to discuss the actions (or inactions) that occurred during the simulation and the outcomes for the patient. This process is call "debriefing"

I began my education in a traditional, no technology, face-to-face classroom, and completed my Master's degree in a high-technology, on-line environment. I am very aware of the challenges and the advantages that both types of education present for students and instructors.

Graceland Participates in Biomedicine Program at University of Iowa

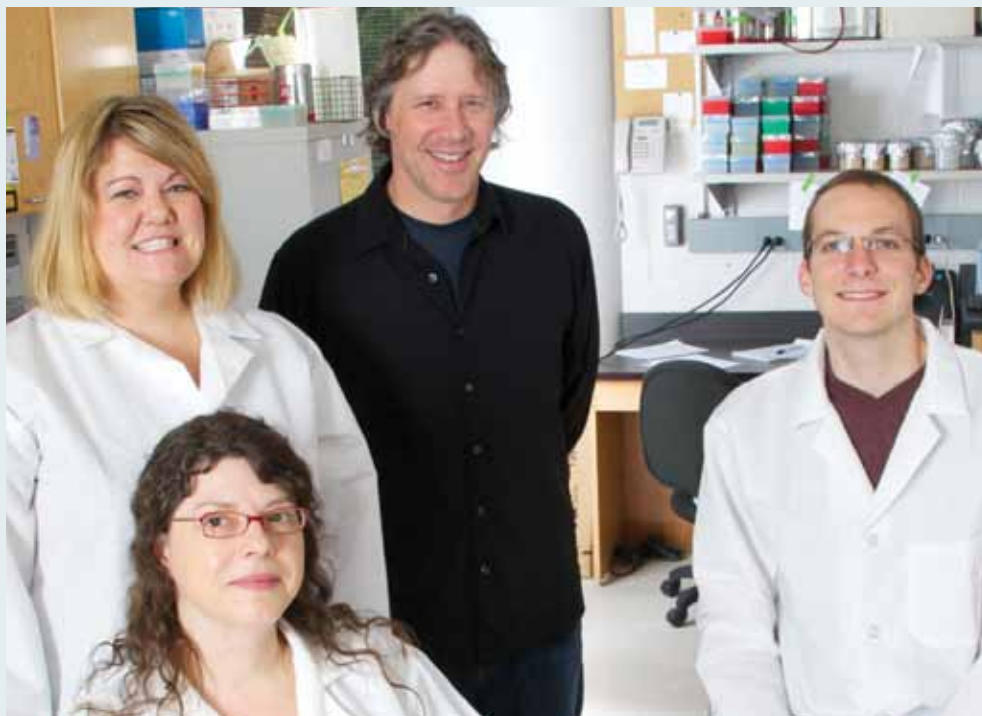
Graceland University student Chris Chambers '14 and Assistant Professor of Biology Dr. Mary Shawgo worked in the lab of University of Iowa researcher John Kirby during the summer of 2013, studying genetic regulation of microbial communities by a biofilm destroyer.

Graceland was one of six colleges participating in the FUTURE (Fostering Undergraduate Talent - Uniting Research and Education) in Biomedicine program at UI. Now in its fifth year, the program pairs faculty from Iowa's primarily undergraduate institutions with UI biomedical scientists in summer-long research collaborations and has created a network of long-term research and learning partnerships that extends to all corners of the state. This is the second time Graceland has participated in the FUTURE program.

"My student not only learned laboratory techniques but more importantly has learned about conducting quality scientific research."

Reflecting on her experience participating in the FUTURE in Biomedicine program, Dr. Shawgo remarked, "The program is very comprehensive. It has allowed me to make great connections with the University of Iowa and faculty from other small Iowa universities as well as strengthen my scientific background. We have made plans to continue the project both here at the University of Iowa and at Graceland University.

"Bringing a student with me this summer has enabled me to bring the project back. Side by side, we have learned the techniques and essential background information to continue our project at Graceland. My student not only learned laboratory techniques but more importantly has learned about conducting quality scientific research. Back home, Chris will be able to help me resume the project earlier than if I had only myself. This will allow my senior research students to have the opportunity to work on a

collaborative effort that has the potential to be published and/or presented at a scientific meeting. These connections also include faculty from small universities that teach similar classes. We have discussed problems, brainstormed ideas and compared lesson plans to improve the way we teach."

The FUTURE program was Chris Chambers' first experience conducting lab research. At first, Chris said, "I was a little intimidated because I didn't know what to expect. But upon arriving, Dr. Kirby and the members of his microbiology lab welcomed Dr. Shawgo and me and very thoroughly explained the premise of our experiment and the procedures involved. In addition, I gleaned a large amount of information about graduate schools, experimental design, and research as both an educational and professional pathway.

"One of the primary objectives of the FUTURE in Biomedicine program is to develop a connection between

the University of Iowa and smaller institutions, such as Graceland, which may only have access to rudimentary research facilities. For my experience particularly, this has been accomplished. The research I conducted this summer is to be part of a larger collaborative effort between Dr. Kirby's lab and GU. This will allow students, such as me, to become more familiar with experimental design and microbiological laboratory techniques in a way that feels more meaningful than simple lab drills. This will lead to a greater integration of basic scientific education and real-world applications.

"To me, this experience has helped to solidify a commitment to scientific exploration. My eyes have been opened to both graduate school and medical school possibilities. While my future remains unclear as to my exact educational pathway, I know that it will involve research and, hopefully, innovation."

The website AffordableCollegesOnline.org and Washington Monthly magazine's "Best Bang for the Buck" ratings system have ranked Graceland University as one of the most affordable private schools in the country.

AffordableCollegesOnline.org (ACO) has ranked Graceland No. 44 in the country out of 54 colleges with distance learning options boasting affordable tuition and alumni with strong earnings after graduation. The flexibility of Graceland's online education programs in theology, nursing and education "allow students to attend school without having to quit their jobs or otherwise disrupt their lives, making online education an increasingly popular option," said President Sellars. "This is why online programs are becoming an essential part of Graceland's education."

Washington Monthly magazine's "Best Bang for the Buck" ranking is designed to help students choose higher education institutions that offer marketable degrees at affordable prices. The magazine's rating system factored in the percentage of students who received Pell Grants, the school's overall graduation rate, and the cost of the school after applying need-based aid. In the general ranking, Graceland was second only to Iowa State University among Iowa colleges and universities. GU was also ranked in the top 25 master degree institutions in the "Best Bang for the Buck" listing. There are only two private universities in the top 25.

GU Stays Strong in U.S. World News and Report Rankings

Graceland University continues to rank as first tier in the Regional University - Midwest category in the *U.S. News & World Report* Best Colleges rankings. This accomplishment marks Graceland's third year in a row of ranking as a first tier Midwestern university. The standing not only provides Graceland with national recognition, but is a testament to the University's progress as it continues to improve the quality of its academic programs.

Highlights from the *Report's* standings include mention of Graceland's small class sizes, with 74.4 percent of classes containing 20 or fewer students; our financial aid services, with 62.4 percent of undergraduate students receiving need-based financial aid and the average need-based scholarship or grant coming in at \$14,979; our admissions process, which the ranking dubbed "selective."

Graceland's Tom Morain Develops Innovative Iowa History Online Course

A college-level course in Iowa history, to be offered during an eight-week period next spring, will be available for college credit for any student in an Iowa private college or university. The first-of-its-kind online course, spearheaded by Graceland, is a collaboration of the Iowa Association of Independent Colleges and Universities (IAICU), the University of Iowa, University of Iowa Press, the State Historical Society of Iowa, Iowa Public Television and the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs.

Dr. Tom Morain, director of government relations at Graceland, developed the curriculum for the course and will teach one section. Dr. Morain's brother, Dr. Rick Morain of Jefferson, will also teach the other spring section. The unique course was announced jointly October 24 on the campus of the University of Iowa in Iowa City by Iowa Governor Terry Branstad, Lieutenant Governor Kim Reynolds, UI President Sally Mason, and IAICU President Gary Steinke. After their remarks, Tom Morain explained how the program would work and what the course would cover.

Parallel to the course offered for academic credit, a new outreach arm of the University of Iowa is exploring the possibility of making the course available free for no credit to anyone who wants to take it whether enrolled in higher education or not. The UI Digital Studio for Public Humanities, directed by Professor Jon Winet, will create an online Iowa History Resources website for Iowa history educators and the general public, including the Iowa history curriculum developed by the Morains. The website will include university materials and provide links to other resources, such as Iowa Public Television, University of Iowa Press, Iowa Public Radio, and the State Historical Society of Iowa. The University of Iowa is funding the project for its first two years.

President Sellars attended the news conference and met with state and university officials. "We are very proud to be part of Graceland's early role in promoting a creative and effective partnership to use resources efficiently," President Sellars said. "This is indeed a win-win situation for everyone."

Distinguished Service Award

This award is given by Graceland University to recognize achievement in a chosen field, service to community, good citizenship, humanitarian service and contribution to society.

Donald P. Brown is a steward in every sense of the word. He manages his time, treasure, and talents through the lense of a deep sense of ministry and profound faith. A high priest in the Community of Christ, he has answered the call “to be willing to serve people at all levels, but mostly at the lowest level of existence.”

After the death of his first wife of 31 years, Don and his three children dedicated themselves to “finding new direction in our lives, to survive, redirect, and flourish with new hope for the future.” With the help of new wife and soul-mate, Abby, Don began putting into use the experience and wisdom he had accumulated over nearly three decades in business management.

Brown became a board member for Give Back Society, helping raise over \$1.4 million in nine years to provide food and medical services to youth and support

groups. He was a founder, board member and fundraiser for Gilda Club Desert Cities, a support group for families of cancer patients. He also mentored the “Odyssey” program which invests in middle and high school youth. Odyssey character building and writing improvement programs zero in on young people and their potential for leading meaningful lives.

Perhaps his work as a charter member of Hidden Harvest is most representative of Don’s values. Founded in 2001, Hidden Harvest has two goals: to provide fresh, healthy, local food to feed the poor and hungry and to establish a living wage for the working poor. Hidden Harvest workers go through fields of vegetables—carrots, tomatoes and green beans—after the farmers’ own crews have already harvested. It gleans what would have been left behind to rot in the field. From a struggling non-profit in 2001 with

an income of \$70,000, Hidden Harvest has increased its budget tenfold and is feeding 50,000-60,000 people below the poverty line, providing 90 pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables per family every month. This year, it will rescue 10,000 tons of gleaned food for distribution to the poor in schools and a dozen Social Security retirement centers. The organization’s budget for 2013 will be in the neighborhood of \$1,000,000. Thanks to the generosity of key supporters like Don, 100% of all donations go directly to feeding the poor.

Don has also shared himself with Graceland serving on the Board of Trustees for 10 years, providing valuable counsel on the Administrative Services and Investment Committees, and sitting on the SkillPath board.

Graduating from Graceland with an Associate of Arts degree in 1967, Don went on to earn a Bachelor of Arts degree from Michigan State and a Masters of Business Administration from Pepperdine University. He has lived a life of service and integrity that represents the very essence of the University’s highest honor, the Distinguished Service Award.

Graceland Award of Recognition

This award is made by Graceland University in recognition of those who have demonstrated special contributions of time, talents, resources and personal sacrifices to benefit Graceland. The recipients do not need to be Graceland alumni.

"The students in my adult classes campaigned hard for it, and the kids in my 6-12th grade classes did a lot of talking, too," said Tonja. "I have a lot of ties to this community. I went to school here and so did my mother's family."

"Art is something you can do your entire life," Tonja said. "It's an escape, and a lot of students are finding out just how peaceful it is." But Tonja emphasizes that art is more than just an enjoyable pastime: "I tell my kids, if nobody thought art was important, then the chair you're sitting in wouldn't exist," she said. "When you think about how someone had to design that chair, you realize that art is everywhere. It's a different way of seeing the world, and it's what our society is built on. If we didn't think creatively, we'd still be stuck in a cave by the water source."

Pursuing a Dream at Graceland

Tonja can't remember a time when she wasn't creative: "Art was where I could breathe, where I could feel good about myself." She inherited a love of art from her mother, learned carpentry skills from her father, and has always loved building with clay and wood, as well as gardening and repurposing household items.

For Tonja, the decision to pursue her bachelor's degree at Graceland was a no-brainer. "I'd spent four summers at Graceland with Upward Bound, and it felt comfortable to me," said Tonja, who decided she could handle the hour-long commute to Lamoni and still manage to

have gotten there without help from Julia Franklin and Rob Stephens, both members of Graceland's art faculty. "Julia and Rob always helped me no matter what, even when I asked a million questions," said Tonja. "My confidence grew so much while I was at Graceland."

In addition to teaching grades 6-12, Tonja teaches adult art classes and organizes an art club for high school students. She takes an enforced break during the summer, but would teach year-round if she could.

The art club has grown tremendously since its inception. Funded with money from concession stand sales, it started with 20 members and now boasts 60. "Our first trip was to the Des Moines Art Center," said Tonja. "Only two kids—my own children—had been to an art museum before, and only three had eaten at a restaurant with cloth napkins. Some had never been outside of Putnam County. You just never know what your impact will be."

For Putnam County students, Tonja's art room is an equal playing ground. "Often, kids who struggle in core classes are superstars in art because they think differently," said Tonja, "and sometimes, the top-notch academic kids find my classes challenging. They have to work hard when they've never had to before." In turn, Tonja must work hard to counter the belief that artists are born, not made.

them off," said Tonja. "When someone says no, think of a different way. Brainstorm with your kids. Start small and let people know your needs. People will donate materials and be generous."

Tonja's career advice is simple. "I tell my students to find something that they're passionate about — then it won't seem like a job. I have often said that I would do my job for free, and my husband tells me to be quiet, because they might just take me up on that. I love, love, love what I do."

Generations of Scholars

Bruce Worthington ('88) always knew that he'd attend Graceland University. His father attended, his mother and two aunts obtained their nursing degrees at 'The San,' and two aunts earned Gold Seals for Scholarship.

Bruce took every computer science, math, and physics course offered during his four years at Graceland, including a semester comprised entirely of independent studies, when he ran out of courses on the official curriculum to take. Following in the steps of his aunts, he earned the Gold Seal with a 4.0 GPA.

"I studied under all of the computer faculty—Jim Jones, Steve Murdock, Will Raiser, Jim Hawley, Ron Smith, and other great teachers. Bruce was offered a fellowship to the University of Michigan and obtained his Master's Degree in 1989. Graceland is growing in enrollment and in nationally recognized academic quality, thanks to alumni and friends like you.


Our Graceland family remains incredibly committed to the Graceland mission. In 2008, while other schools were cutting back on donor expectations, Graceland launched the largest-ever Graceland Forever capital campaign--\$75 million. I am pleased to report that the Graceland family has responded as predicted. We have already raised 85% of that goal -- \$63.6 mil.

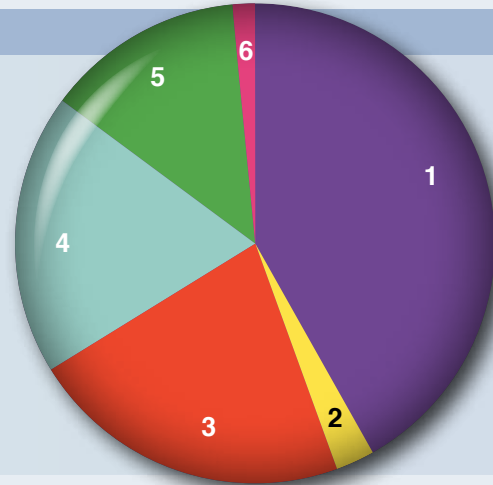

Financial Highlights: University Operating Budget Results for 2012-13

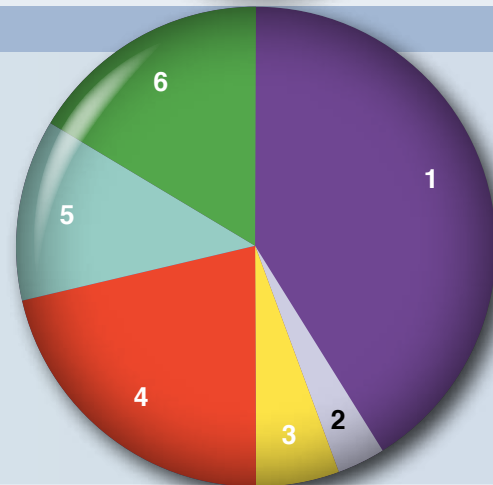
